

UNIFORMS

Assignment of uniforms: All members of the Chamber and Symphony orchestras will be expected to wear uniforms for performances. We will make every effort to assign a complete and properly fitting uniform for every student. **However**, in some cases students may need to provide part of their uniform. Also, we cannot guarantee your preferred size. Please remember that this is a uniform.

This year, uniform assignments will be made in advance. Please fill out the enclosed uniform sizing form and return with the other forms in this packet. If this is not turned in on time, you risk not being assigned an adequate uniform. Instructions on measurement taking are included on the form.

Alterations: No permanent alterations may be made to uniforms! Hemming the garment is your responsibility. Do not cut the garment. Do not use iron on hem tape.

Care of Uniforms: It is the student's responsibility to maintain the uniform. Lost buttons will be replaced and uniforms should be cleaned or spot cleaned after every wearing. Tuxes, pants, vest, white ties, and chamber dresses must be dry-cleaned. Orchestra dresses and men's shirts are machine washable.

Uniform returns: All uniforms must be returned clean and in good repair within two weeks of the last performance where uniforms are worn (usually the concerto concert).

Uniforms must be:

- Laundered or dry-cleaned (see above)
- On hangars
- In a garment or dry-cleaning bag
- Labeled with your name and grade if you do not want to be charged with replacing the garment.

Uniforms should not be:

- Dirty
- Stuffed in a bag
- Unlabeled
